## **Our Services**

- **LA** also offers the Muslim ladies in Calgary, particularly new immigrants, the chance to meet other fellow-Muslim ladies and help them involve into the larger community by holding a biweekly Friday get-together in the South West Masjid.
- **LA** helps Muslim kids and teens get acquainted with the principles of Islam and the proper way to mix with others within an Islamic framework by means of weekly halaqas that combine both religious instruction and enjoyable activities.
- **LA** holds a bimonthly potluck titled 'Meet and Greet' in the South West Masjid. Every potluck involves activities, religious competition and mother-daughter contests.
- **LA** strives to support vulnerable and underprivileged Muslim ladies (ladies in women's shelter, in hospices, hospitals, jails, senior homes, etc..).
