*The Creator And
Lord
Of The Universe*

Allah is the name of the true One God in the Arabic language. In the Hebrew language His name is Eloh, Elohim for respect. It is well known that when a word is borrowed from one language to another its spelling and pronunciation are often altered. It is, therefore, reasonable to say that Eloh, God and Allah are names of the same Deity of Abraham believed by Judaism, Christianity and Islam. If you are an Arab, Christian, Jew or Muslim, you pray to Allah. To question that is like arguing that French speakers don't worship God, they worship something else called "dieu".

Islam is the most rigorously monotheistic religion among the three dedicated to the worship of Allah, never seen by a human eye.

Who Is Allah and What are His Attributes

"Proclaim: Allah is One. Allah is Eternal. He neither begets nor was begotten." Quran 112:1-4. **"Nothing is like unto Him."** Quran 42:11. **"If there were therein Gods besides Allah, then verily both (the heavens and the earth) would have collapsed into disorder and chaos. Glorified be Allah, the Lord of the Throne, transcendent beyond all they ascribe unto Him."** Quran 21:22. **"Sight can never reach Him; His sight reaches all things."** Quran 6:103. **"And proclaim: Praise be to Allah, Who has not taken unto Himself a son, and Who has no partner in the Sovereignty, nor has He (need for) any protecting friend through dependence".** Quran 17:111. **"Allah! There is no God save Him."** Quran 3:2, 2:255. **"Is there any God beside Allah?**

Nay, but they are folk who ascribe equals (unto Him)! Quran 27:60. "Is there any God beside Allah? Nay, but most of them know not." Quran 27:61. **"And He is the Mighty, the Wise. His is the Sovereignty of the heavens and the earth; He gives life and He gives death; and He is able to do all things. He is the First and the Last, and the Outward and the Inward; and He is the Knower of all things."** Quran 57:1-3. **"The Beneficent, the Merciful: Owner of the Day of Judgment."** Quran 1:3-4. **"And you seek the Grace of Allah: for Allah is Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful."** Quran 73:20.

Allah the Creator

"Have not those who disbelieve known that the heavens and the earth were of one piece, then We parted them, and We made every living thing from water? Will they not then believe?" Quran 21:30. **"And He it is Who created the night and the day, and the sun and the moon. They float each in an orbit... And from among His signs are the night and the day, and the sun and the moon. Prostrate not to the sun nor to the moon, but prostrate to Allah Who created them, if you (really) worship Him."** Quran 21:33, 41:37. **"He has created man: He has imparted unto him articulate thought and speech. [At His behest] the sun and the moon run their appointed courses; the stars and the trees prostrate themselves [before Him]. And the skies has He raised high, and has devised [for all things] a measure, so that you [too, O men,] might never transgress the measure [of what is right]: weigh, therefore, [your deeds] with equity, and cut not the measure short!"** Quran 55:3-9. **"He it is Who has made the sun a [source of] radiant light and the moon shining [surface], and has determined for it phases so that you might know how to compute the years and to measure [time]. None of this has Allah created without [an inner] truth. Clearly does He spell out these messages unto people of [innate] knowledge."** Quran 10:5. **"Such is Allah, your Lord. There is no god except Him, the Creator of all things, so serve Him. And He takes care of all things."** Quran 6:102.

Our Universe was not created by accident

The more science advances the more it gives us accurate persuasive proof of a creator behind the entire phenomenon that control our universe such as law of heat (Thermal Energy or Second Law of Thermodynamics), the law of atoms dynamics and Solar Energy. Moreover it is not accidental that:

1. If the earth's crust were little thicker than its present thickness, it would absorb the carbon dioxide and oxygen and there would be no life on earth
2. If the air were not higher in distance, millions of meteors burning in space would fall on the earth and would set fire to all inflammable objects.
3. If the sun gave fewer rays, we would be frozen. On the contrary, if it gave out more rays, we would have been turned into ashes long ago.
4. If the moon were further 20,000 miles instead of its present distance, the tide would be so powerful that it could engulf the earth twice a day.
5. If the night were ten times longer, the summer solar heat would burn plants every day and plants would be frozen every night
6. If Oxygen constitutes 50 percent of the atmosphere instead of 21, all combustible substances would be liable to burning. Similarly, if oxygen represents 10% of the air, there would be no human life on earth. Without rain, the earth would become a lifeless desert, likewise without wind, sea and oceans, living creatures would die
7. If the water of the ocean were sweet, it would turn bad and there would be no life on earth.
8. If the axis of the earth were straight instead of its present inclination of 23 degree, all the drops of the vaporized seawater would be accumulated in only the north and the south poles of the earth and the continents would be frozen
9. If the earth directed only towards one side of the sun, like Mercury, there would be either everlasting night or everlasting daylight.
10. Without the law of gravity, there would be no attracting force among atoms; molecules to join

them, consequently, the sun and the earth would not keep their present locations.

11. Without thermal laws, the earth would be frozen
12. Without mountains, there would be no earth crust

Allah Revealed the Truth – Option Given

"We revealed to you the Book in truth, that you may proclaim it to the world. Whoever decides to be guided by its guidance does so to his own credit. Whoever rejects its guidance does so to his own discredit and you are not a warder over them." Quran 39:41. **"Let there be no compulsion [or coercion] in religion: Truth stands out clear from error; whoever rejects evil and believes in Allah has grasped the most trustworthy handhold that never breaks. And Allah hears and knows all things."** Quran 2:256. **"And say: The Truth [has now come] from your Lord: let, then him who wills, believe in it, and let him who wills, reject it."** Quran 18:29. **"No person is responsible for the guilt of another. To every person belongs the merit or demerit of what he had wrought... Allah does not charge a person with more than he can bear. Therefore, to everyone belongs the credit or discredit which he had personally earned."** Quran 53:38-39, 2:286. **"Whoever guides himself by Our revelation does so to his own credit. Whoever goes astray does so to his own peril. Nobody will be responsible for another's deeds, and We will not judge but after a messenger sent [to proclaim and warn] ... Whoever does good will have that good reckoned for him. Whoever does evil will have that evil marked against him. Your Lord commits no injustice to His servants."** Quran 17:15, 41:46.

Seeking Knowledge

The way to know Allah is through the signs that indicate Him. For that reason, Allah in His book; the Quran asks us many times to seek knowledge and reflect on what we see:

"He it is Who sends down water (rain) from the sky; from it you drink and from it (grows) the

vegetation on which you send your cattle to graze. With it He causes to grow for you the crops, the olives, the date palms, the grapes, and every kind of fruit. Verily! In this is indeed an evident proof and a manifest sign for people who give thought." Quran 16:10 –11

"And among His Signs is the creation of the heavens and the earth, and the difference of your languages and colours. Verily, in that are indeed signs for men of sound knowledge" Quran 30-22

For that reason, Islam obliges Muslim to gain knowledge because it is the means through which one understands Islam well. The Quran declares: **"And those who have been given knowledge see that what is revealed to you (O Muhammad (peace be upon him)) from your Lord is the truth, and that it guides to the Path of the Exalted in Might, Owner of all praise"** Quran: 34-6

"It is only those who have knowledge among His slaves that fear Allah. Verily, Allah is All-Mighty, Oft-Forgiving" Quran: 58-12

Allah Guides those who search for Him and believe in Him

Once you recognize and believe in Allah, Allah guides you back with faith, serenity and peace. **"whosoever believes in Allah, He guides his heart (to the true Faith with certainty, i.e. what has befallen him was already written for him by Allah from the Qadar (Divine Preordainments)) and Allah is the All-Knower of everything"**. Quran: 64-11,

So the secret lies within man himself **"So when they turned away (from the Path of Allah), Allah turned their hearts away (from the Right Path). And Allah guides not the people who are rebellious, disobedient to Allah)"** Quran 61 –5 (part).

The Quran states that Allah loves those who love him (5:54), those who do good deeds (2:195), who ask His forgiveness (2:222), who purify themselves (2,222), who revere Him and who are steadfast (3:146), those who rely on Him (3:159), who act justly (5:42), who strive for His cause (61:4), and follow the example of the Prophet (3:31)

Allah Outline those He Will Not Guide

Allah states to us that he will prevent people with specific characteristics from seeing His signs and believing in Him **"I shall turn away from My Ayat (proof, evidences, verses, lessons, signs, revelations, etc) those who behave arrogantly on the earth, without a right, and (even) if they see all the Ayat, they will not believe in them. And if they see the way of righteousness, they will not adopt it as the Way, but if they see the way of error, they will adopt that way, that is because they have rejected Our Ayat and were heedless (to learn a lesson) from them"** Quran7-146.

"And who does more wrong than the one who invents a lie against Allah, while he is being invited to Islam? And Allah guides not the people who are Zâlimûn (polytheists, wrong-doers and disbelievers) folk" Quran 61-7, **"Truly, Allah guides not him who is a liar, and a disbeliever"** Quran 39-3,

The question, which arises here, is, "How can all people be expected to believe in Allah given their varying- backgrounds, societies and cultures? For people to be responsible for worshipping Allah they all have to have access to knowledge of Allah. The final revelation teaches that all mankind have the recognition of Allah imprinted on their souls, a part of their very nature with which they are created.
